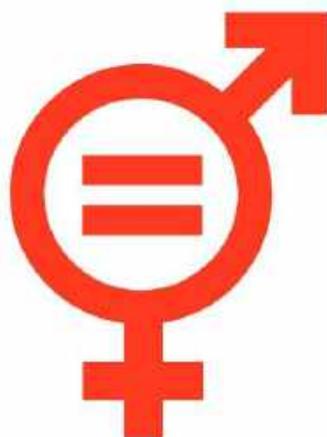

Wall of Wonders - 17 Goals

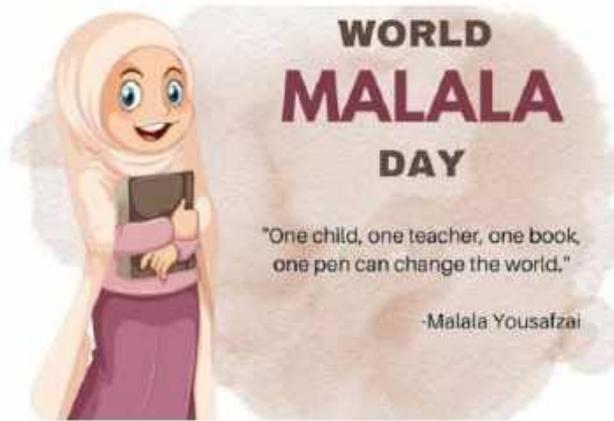

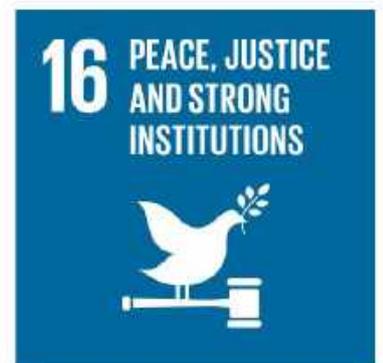
The purpose of this wall is to create awareness and inspire positive actions in everyday life. It encourages everyone to understand their role in shaping a brighter and more sustainable future.
